Mounting the Hub







Choose placement of the Hub to be within 6' a GFCI outlet, ideally on the side of the house near the utilities, or on a stake/post. It must also be 30" above the ground to avoid exposure to water/snow/other elements.

Using the provided mounting template, mark and drill pilot holes (1/8" bit). Install the screws by using a drill bit or Phillip's Head Screwdriver

Once the screws are seated, hang the Hub on the structure by aligning the screw heads with their corresponding hooks on the Hub.








Mount the Repellers
















Connect the Repellers



Connect a cable from the Hub to the end of the corresponding pigtail on the first repeller (each repeller has two). Connections should be threaded finger tight, do not use tools or over-tighten.

Then connect the other pigtail of the first repeller to the proper pigtail of the next repeller in sequence, repeat until all repellers are connected in a single chain.

TEST the Repellers




Lights circle from left to right, around the device

Plug in the hub and press the power button. The ring around the Hub button should light blue. Check each repeller to ensure they are illuminated.


Lights are located halfway up the repeller and circle the entire device. A chasing "amber" light indicates that the repeller is heating up (functioning normally).

Turn off the system by pressing the power button on the Hub. Continue with final installation of the repellers and cables.










Insert Repellent Cartridges

- ☐ Remove the repeller hood by twisting ¼ turn counter-clockwise
- Remove the cap from the cartridge by twisting the cap counter clockwise.
- Align the cutouts on cartridge with bumps on repeller head, press up until you feel it click into place.
- Replace the repeller hood and the system is ready to operate.
- Use the included Allen key to lock the repeller and prevent access by pets/children, etc. The repeller will need to be unlocked in order to service/replace cartridges.



Note: Cartridges attach easily, but are more difficult to remove.
